### Luke 1:35 NASB (Holy Spirit, Most High, holy Child...all God, but One God)

<sup>35</sup> The angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; for that reason also the holy Child will be called the Son of God.

## Matthew 28:19 NASB (we make disciples in the name of all three, but they are all unified as one God)

<sup>19</sup> Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,

Matthew 3:16-17 NASB (Jesus the King and Messiah, the Spirit the Empowered and Comforter, the Father the Gift Giver and Final Approver of all things). See Luke 3:21-22 also.

<sup>16</sup> After He was baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and ⊌he saw the <u>Spirit of God</u> descending as a dove *and* ⊌settling on Him, <sup>17</sup> and behold, a voice from the heavens said, "<u>This is ⊌My beloved Son</u> (the Father speaking about **His Son**), with whom I am well pleased."

John 14:16-17 (Jesus askes the Father for the Holy Spirit...the Helper...we who have Jesus have the Spirit also, who knows God because He is God)

The Holy Spirit

<sup>16</sup> I will ask the Father, and He will give you another 

Helper, so that He may be with you forever; 

the Helper is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him; but you know Him because He remains with you and will be in you.

1 Peter 1:1-2 NASB (The Father has the foreknowledge, the work done by the Spirit, the command to obey from Jesus...all different dimensions of the same will and purpose)

1 Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ,

To those who reside as strangers, scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, who are chosen <sup>2</sup> according to the foreknowledge of <u>God the Father</u>, by the sanctifying <u>work of the Spirit</u>, ato <u>obey Jesus Christ</u> and be sprinkled with His blood: May grace and peace be multiplied to you.

### 1 Corinthians 12:4-6 NASB (it's the same God)

<sup>4</sup> Now there are varieties of gifts, but the <u>same Spirit</u>. <sup>5</sup> And there are varieties of ministries, and the <u>same Lord</u>. <sup>6</sup> There are varieties of effects, but the <u>same God</u> who works all things in all *persons*.

### Ephesians 4:4-6 NASB (it's all one God and one thing)

<sup>4</sup> There is one body and <u>one Spirit</u>, just as you also were called in one hope of your calling; <sup>5</sup> <u>one Lord</u>, one faith, one baptism, <sup>6</sup> <u>one God and Father</u> of all who is over all and through all and in all.


### Colossians 1:15-17 NASB (Jesus is God, a visible expression)

<sup>15</sup> □He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation: <sup>16</sup> for □by Him all things were created, *both* in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones, or dominions, or rulers, or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him. <sup>17</sup> He □is before all things, and in Him all things □hold together.

# John 14:9-11 NASB (Jesus in the Father, the Father in Jesus)

<sup>9</sup> Jesus \*said to him, "Have I been with wyou for so long a time, and *yet* wyou have not come to know Me, Philip? The one who has seen Me has seen the Father; how *can* you say, 'Show us the Father'? <sup>10</sup> Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own, but the Father, as He remains in Me, does His works. <sup>11</sup> Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; otherwise believe because of the works

Think of it this way...like a cube...when does the face of one side blend into the other? Can you separate them? It is One Cube with three different Faces.



### John 10:30-36 NASB (People sometimes struggle with it, but Jesus and the Father are One God)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>30</sup> I (Jesus) and the Father are aone."

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>31</sup> The Jews picked up stones again to stone Him. <sup>32</sup> Jesus replied to them, "I showed you many good works from the Father; for which of them are you stoning Me?" <sup>33</sup> The Jews answered Him, "We are not stoning You for a good work, but for blasphemy; and because You, being a man, make Yourself *out to be* God." <sup>34</sup> Jesus answered them, "Has it not been written in your Law: 'I SAID, YOU ARE GODS'? <sup>35</sup> If he called them gods, to whom the word of God came (and the Scripture cannot be nullified), <sup>36</sup> are you saying of Him whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?

### Mark 12:29 NASB (Jesus, affirming Deut 6:4)


